Mass confrontation and DOGSO.

What is confrontation? To meet face to face and physical interference between playeers. Who confronts who?: player v player or v Referee or v Assistant Referee or team mate or v manager,

Referee needs to be aleert, aware and take disciplinary action.

Videos of confrontation: action- get a view, note shirt colour and numbers, determine instigator and retaliater and anyone else. Keep watching.

DOGSO: check general direction of player, distance from gaol and ball. Is player facing goal, position of defenders,
